- 30/101 Piper-Heidsieck "Essential" Cuvee Brut NV** **Gls /Btl**
€16/€75
Essential is a multi-vintage cuvée featuring a blend of 3 varieties. Its magnificent structure, balance and freshness ensure that this Extra-Brut represents the iconic style of the House.
- 31/102 Piper-Heidsieck "Rosé Sauvage" NV** **€17/€80**
Top rosé Champagne to try Glowing deep cherry pink in color, this really is a statement rosé Champagne, the aromas just as seductive as the hue. Strawberries, peaches and plums dominate the palate, with a spiced orange note to the finish.
- 103 KRUG Vintage 1973** **€700**
Krug is a remarkable Champagne House which only makes prestige cuvées. The wines – with their distinctive rich, complex, oxidative style – are some of the region's best.
- 104 Dom Perignon Vintage 2013** **€290**
Aromas of almond and powdered cocoa develop gradually into white fruit with hints of dried flowers. The full taste lingers with the utmost elegance on a sappy, spicy note.
- 105 Moët & Chandon Impérial Brut NV** **€95**
A lovely citrus nose that shows hints of white flowers, minerals and brioche; it is smooth textured with graceful structure and bright acidity.
- 106 Taittinger Prestige Rosé NV** **€110**
Firm and spicy, this chalky rosé shows tightly knit flavours of black raspberry and cherry fruit, fresh ginger and pink grapefruit zest, with hints of honey and almond skin.

The Pinot Meunier dominant blend gives richness of the red berry fruit to this beautiful champagne.

A lovely citrus nose that shows hints of white flowers, minerals and brioche; it is smooth textured with graceful structure and bright acidity.

The wine appears in a delightful pinkish hue, and its aroma is a fusion of fruity and floral scents. On the palate, the wine offers a refreshing balance of acidity and sweetness, with hints of ripe strawberries and cherries.

Nice bottle of bubbles. Crisp and dry with just right amount of acidity.

40/400 LOL by Laulerie Rose, Bergerac (V)

Attractively refreshing aromas of marshmallow and grenadine give way to harmonious notes of strawberry and apricot with a round mouth feel, good body and a lingering finish.

41/401 Sauvignon Blanc Pa Road, Marlborough, (V)
€11.00/€44

The lemon zest and passionfruit theme carry through the palate, supported by delicate black currant and aniseed notes. The finish is crisp and clean with hints of lingering spice and a touch of chalky minerality.

42/402 Chardonnay Domaine de l'Herré, Côte's de Gascogne €10.00/€40

Deep yellow with topaz tints. Fresh nose with acacia, pear and sweet almond-tinged white flowers. The palate is fresh, full and round balanced, with subtle brioche taste, honey and preserved lemon notes.

43/403 Falanghina del Sannio, Campania
€10.00/€40

Characteristic fruity bouquet of good intensity. Acidity and sapidity increase progressively, giving a balanced, pleasant and refreshing wine.

45/405 Riesling Balthasar Röss, Hattenheim-Rheingau (O) €11/€44

A wonderfully fresh and elegant, off-dry Riesling. The palate is concentrated and quite decadent, peach tart and mango offset by crunchy green apple and grapefruit, finishing off-dry with a lingering sweetness, with residual hints of musk and honey.

46/406 Bordeaux Blanc Château Bauduc €10.50/€42

An unoaked Sauvignon Blanc packed with refined nettle and lemon grass zing and unripe nectarines. Crisp and dry, with well-balanced acidity, a tropical-fruit laden mid-palate, and refreshing citrus on the finish.

47/407 Pinot Grigio, Trentino Forte Alto (V) €10.00/€40

Elegant, dry Pinot Grigio with apple and banana fruit aromas, floral lift in the mouth, and a clean, crisp finish.

50/410 Merlot Château Les Moutins, Bordeaux €10.00/€40
Ripe red fruit, cherries and berries, very soft with some malolactic characteristics.

51/411 Cabernet Sauvignon Siegel Reserva, Valle de Colchagua €10.00/€40
Blackcurrant and ripe fruits-of-the-forest flavours make this a rich and fruity wine with a subtle seasoning of vanilla.

52/412 Montepulciano Il Bucco, d' Abruzzo €11.00/€44
A deliciously soft and rounded Montepulciano. Lovely plum and blackcurrant fruits, medium bodied.

53/413 Crianza Rioja Hacienda El Olmo, Rioja Baja €9.50/€38
Some earth and leather wander through strawberry and cherry, tobacco, earth, brush and undergrowth. There's a gorgeous sweet seeds/tannin character effortlessly expressing the wine's perfect ripeness, with an open, freely flowing palate framed by gentle grip and terrific natural acid freshness.

54/414 Malbec Cassone Reserva, Mendoza €10.00/€40
90-year-old vineyards give this wine a finer and more elegant quality. It has soft summer fruit flavours with hints of pepper and spice.

55/415 Carmenere Antawara Reserva, Maipo Valley €9.50/€38
Deep ruby red with violet tints, this Reserve Carménère is bursting with fruit and spice notes, red fruit and blueberries, with hints of toasted oak and vanilla. Full bodied and well balanced, with velvety tannins and a fine natural acidity, ripe fruit flavours intermingle with chocolate powder and exotic spices on a rounded and silky palate.

56/278 Cabernet Sauvignon "NO Fine Print", Sierra Foothills California €15/ €60
There is so much delicious, black fruit and spice upfront here. The wine feels very Cab Sav. Think blackcurrant, brambles and a touch of savoury bitterness. A touch of Merlot helps keep the wine fruit forward and juicy, whilst a dash of Petite Sirah helps add structure and richness.

57/417 Les Plans Famille Gras, Vaucluse Rhone €10.00/€40
Syrah, Grenache and a touch of Cabernet & Merlot. Producer Yves Gras based in Gigondas Southern Rhône makes this rich & generous wine with aromas & flavours of red & dark fruit, wild herbs & spice. Warm hearted red!

Burgundy White Selection

- 110 Chablis Domaine Corinne Perchaud, 2021 (O) €60**
This wine has intense fruity aromas with good minerality and a lively acidity on the palate. It is well balanced, with great aromatic purity and roundness.
- 111 Chablis 1er Cru Montmain, Gerard Tremblay 2019 €78**
Pale, bright, green-tinged yellow. The forty-year-old vines in the 1er Cru Montmain vineyard contribute to the extra weight in this wine. 30% of the wine is aged in futs de chene. A fine wine with a profound mineral nose, deceptive weight and a lingering finish
- 112 Puligny-Montrachet Patriarche, Côte de Beaune 2017 €88**
Fine nose delivering, when twisted and turned, woody, -oral and nutty -flavours such as almonds and hazelnuts.
- 113 Puligny-Montrachet 1er Cru 'Sous le Puits' Domaine Larue, Côte de Beaune 2020 €115**
Pronounced aromas of grilled/smoked almond, peach, lime and pear. On the palate, round and rich in texture with sweet almond and honey notes and a firm mineral backbone. The oak is nicely integrated and the finish lengthy.
- 114 Chassagne-Montrachet 1er Cru 'Morgeot' Ballot Millot, 2020 €140**
A world-class White Burgundy produced in extremely minimal quantities. Chassagne-Montrachet 1er Cru Morgeot Tête du Clos comes from a small, sub-hectare plot of vines rooted in the highest part of Les Morgeots, directly under La Romanée. Vines are sustainably farmed and planted in rocky, limestone-heavy soils. Very intense, tensile expression of Chassagne-Montrachet.
- 115 Givry Blanc 'En Cheneves' Domaine Desvignes, Côte Chalonnaise 2020 €75**
The wine is straight, carried by a limestone frame which brings a lot of freshness to the cuvée. Beautiful, very fresh floral notes, citrus, lemon, mixed with a few notes of marshmallow.
A controlled aging with 20% of new oak, allows to preserve the aromatic freshness, a beautiful balanced length, on an elegant and floral finish, typical of the terroir of Chenèves.

Loire White Selection

- 118 Sancerre Domain Sylvain Bailly €58**
Light straw in colour, flowerily blossom and minerally hints on the nose. Dry, smooth and elegant on the palate.
- 119 Sauvignon Blanc" L'Enfant Rebelle" Antoine de la Farge, €48**
Bright pale gold with green highlights. The nose reveals lemon aromas, white blossom, grapefruits underpinned with a hint of subtlety and minerality. These aromas come throughout the palate along with exotic touches.
- 120 Touraine Sauvignon Blanc, Vincent Lacour €45**
Light, crisp, dry, traditional apple and citrus but massive tropical fruit new world style, mango, passionfruit, soft palette. Delicate and harmonious, the wine is marked by floral-tinged notes and a mineral-driven finish.
- 121 Muscadet Saint Fiacre Sur Maine, De Sèrve Et Maine Sur Lie €42**
Pear, cantaloupe skin and brine on the nose. Medium body. Acidity and alcohol with a ripe and textured mouthfeel. Lovely expression of Muscadet with charm and complexity.
- 122 Chenin Blanc Clos de Saint Yves, Domaine des Baumard Savennieres, €57**
Intense aromas of orchard fruit, honey, blossom and a hint of gun smoke. The palate is clean and bright with ripe fruit, minerality and zesty acidity.

Languedoc White Selection

- 125 Gris Blanc, Gérard Bertrand €42**
A pale pink rosé, perfect for a mid-summer's eve with a scent of lychee, lime, and strawberry and a refreshing taste of green apple, pink grapefruit and peach.
- 126 Viognier, Baron de Badassier, Côte's de Thau, (V) €39**
This Viognier is made in a fresh, modern style. It offers subtle aromas of almond and honey on the nose. Rounded on the palate, with guava and apricot flavours, it is balanced by a refreshing acidity on the finish.

Rhône White Selection

- 129 Condrieu Chanson, Stephane Montez Domaine du Monteillet €85**
This cuvée located in the heart of the Condrieu appellation comes only from the place called "Chanson". This plot selection comes from a steep and arid hillside of muscovite granite. Powerful scents of flowers and dried fruits, more saline on the palate, all in finesse, length and grace, harmonious finish still a little restrained, a lot of subtlety.
- 130 Côte's du Rhône White "La Lumière" - 2020 €62**
White flowers, pear, lemon, and hints of honey on the nose. Elegant, The Roussanne & Bourboulenc blend gives a rich, layered wine with notes of white flowers, stone fruits and spices. Really good structure and richness in the mid-palate and a good acidity that balances the round. ripe fruit flavours.

Alsace White Selection

- 133 "Gentil" Hugel, Riquewihr €42**
Typically blended from all of the varieties grown in Alsace, or more accurately, in the vineyards of the producer, the style captures many of the wonderful aspects of the region. Fresh flavours of apple, petals, citrus fruit and blossom are very well-balanced.
- 134 Gewurztraminer Réserve, Cave de Hunawihr, Haut-Rhin €47**
The nose is very complex with very delicate perfumes of lychee, mango and particularly rose. Full-bodied, this off dry wine has a refreshing acidity with roses lingering on the long finish.

Italian White Selection

- 136 Pinot Grigio Franz Haas, Trentino Alto Adige €46**
Pale straw in colour. Dry, medium body and medium acidity. Lot of citrus, stone fruit and mineral notes. Hint of honey finishing.
- 137 Pinot Grigio Blush Cantina di Monteforte, Veneto €40**
Lovely salmon-pink colour, this fruity Rosato has delicate perfumes of red cherries and strawberries. The palate is dry and intense with lingering strawberry hints on the finish.
- 138 Soave Classico Superiore DOCG Masi COLBARACA, Veneto (O) €45**
One of the classics of the great Veronese tradition, made by Masi in a contemporary style. Colbaraca is produced with Garganega grapes grown in the Masi-owned organically cultivated vineyards in the historic Soave area. It is characterised by its impressive structure and marked elegance.
- 139 Carricante Cusumano Alta Mora Etna Bianco, Sicilia €68**
Etna Bianco is made entirely from the indigenous Sicilian grape. Fuller in body, fresh, fruity with great minerality and a crisp citrusy finish. Made only in stainless steel, this pure expression of Carricante is brilliant and sharp in terms of aromas, with piercing tones of citrus, minty apple and crushed stone.

Spain White Selection

142 Verdejo Pago del Cielo Celeste, Rueda €39

A potently aromatic nose displaying varietal notes of fennel and green almond with white floral undertones. Silky and firm on the palate, with fine, elegant acidity conferring great length.

143 Albarino Etra, Rias Baixas €44

Medium straw colour. Medium nose intensity of pear, green apples and lemon. Dry, medium body with mineral notes. Pear aftertaste.

144 Garnacha Blanca Izadi Larrossa, Rioja €35

Bright aromas of lemon peel, pear and honeysuckle entice on the nose. The palate has superb purity of fruit, with notes of stone fruit and zesty acidity leading to a refreshing, fruit-driven finish at the end.

145 Palomino As de Mirabrás, Jerez €45

It's a fresh, sapid, white wine from old Palomino vines grown in chalky albariza soil close to the sea in Jerez. a combination of classic sherry tones like yeast, brioche and herbs together with rather classic white wine aromas like quince, honey and ripe white fruit. Nutty flavours of an older Manzanilla in the mouth, albeit fruitier.

Portugal White Selection

148 Loureiro-Alvarinho Quinta de Azevedo, Vinho Verde €40

It has an intense aroma of ripe mango, nectarine and hints of well-ripened citrus. Refreshing on the palate with aromatic citrus notes and a firm, but very well-integrated, acidity.

149 Alvarinho Reserva, Quinta de Azevedo, Vinho Verde €46

On the palate, it has a great concentration of flavour. A lively acidity invites a long and balanced finish.

Hungarian White Selection

151 Furmint Dobogo, Tokaji (V) €65

The Dobogo Tokaji Furmint is a rich, dry Furmint wine matured Hungarian oak casks for 10-12 months before being bottled. Medium gold in colour with a complex array of aromas including fresh notes of lime, pear, ripe apple, quince, herbs, chamomile and a hint of spiciness. The taught acid structure balances the ripe fruit concentration and salty, mineral character, which lingers on the elegant finish. This is a young and dynamic wine.

Croatia White Selection

- 153 Malvazija Istarska `Alba`, Matošević, €46**
Pale lemon in colour. The wine is bursting with aromas of elderflower, acacia, lime zest, quince, pear, apricot and ripe nectarine. An incredibly crisp acidity balances the concentration of flavours.

Austrian White Selection

- 157 Grüner Veltliner Markus Huber "TERRASSEN" €46**
Green apples, kiwi fruit, lemon verbena and some nutmeg on the nose. Creamy and balanced with a caressing, ripe and flavourful palate.
- 158 Grüner Veltliner Stift Klosterneuburg (V) €47**
This Grüner is fruity with a hint of pepper, aromas of fresh apple and grapefruit and a palate that displays both finesse and herbaceous expression with lime notes, lots of ripe juicy pear and that scintillating hit of white pepper coupled with refreshingly high acidity.

Germain White Selection

- 160 Riesling Bischel Gau-Algesheim, Rheinhessen €44**
Aromas of peach and fresh limes, on the palate it presents with delicate, juicy minerality, a fine interplay of fruit sweetness and acidity lending finesse and freshness. The finish is bone dry, deliciously crisp and quenching.

Chile White Selection

- 163 Chardonnay 20 Barrels Limited Edition, Cono Sur, Casablanca Valley €49**
Its most distinguishing feature is its well-achieved balance between citrus notes and complex minerality, both in nose and mouth. An elegant and fresh wine, with soft notes of French oak, result of its time in barrel. A very mineral Chardonnay with a full, fresh and complex palate.

Australian White Selection

- 166 Chardonnay Berton Foundstone, High Eden €40**
An appealing fruit driven wine that has aromas of candied lemon, lime and honeydew melon. The palate is a fusion of sweet citrus, pear drop and ripe melon flavours that continue to a long and zesty finish.
- 167 Riesling, "Julius", Henschke, Eden Valley €60**

Excellent flavour intensity showing concentrated citrus Flavors of lime juice and Meyer lemon, supported by minerality and crispness for an incredibly long and dry finish .

New Zealand White Selection

170 Pinot Gris Te Pa, Marlborough €47

Classic Pinot Gris has notes of white pear, nectarine and subtle jasmine flowers show a wine of true distinction and class. The palate exudes purity and poise, with rich flavours of white peach and creamy nougat. A truly sensational glass of wine.

171 Chardonnay Greywacke, Marlborough €68

Pale gold on colour, strong backbone of powerful acidity. Deep on honeyed yellow fruits and Grapefruit undertones. Medium bodied wine with long creamy finish demonstrating the oak intensity.

172 Sauvignon Blanc Kim Crawford, Marlborough €46

Lot of crisp citruses (grapefruit and lemon) Blanc with passion fruit. Grass and bell pepper notes. Dry with medium acidity and medium body.

United States White Selection

176 Chardonnay Rutherford Ranch, Napa Valley €46

Yellow to pale gold in colour. Apple, lemon, pear on the nose. Medium body wine with Nice acidity. Oaky.

178 Chardonnay De Loach Vineyard, Russian River Valley €52

Crisp refreshing notes of green apple, pears and stone fruit. Good acidity and medium length Finish. Slightly oaky.

South African White Selection

181 Chardonnay Wild Yeast Springfield Estate, Robertson €42

Unwooded, immensely complex aromas of pineapple and pear mingling with nutty, yeasty cookie dough notes from extended lees ageing. The palate structure is firm, crisp and grippy.

182 Chardonnay Jordan, Stellenbosch €40

Unoaked Light straw colour, lots of citrus and stone fruit in flavour. Smooth, creamy. Showing presence of sweetness on the palate.

183 Chenin Blanc Spice Route, Swartland €46

Complex nose with tropical fruits and peach followed by flinty notes. The palate is rich and broad, reminiscent of the koffiekliip soils, with well-balanced acidity from the first picking.

Bordeaux Red Selection

200 Château Léoville Barton, Saint-Julien 2nd Growth 2015 €175

Léoville Barton has one of the richest bouquets in the appellation, boasting almost ostentatious blackberry, raspberry and bilberry scents on the nose, suffused with crushed limestone and light graphite aromas, leather, wood, black fruits, elegant, soft tannin. Smoke on the end.

201 Château Lynch-Bages, Pauillac 5th Growth 2012 €240

Situated at the entrance of Pauillac, Château Lynch Bages is an estate that has left its mark on the history of the Médoc wine region. The 2012 Lynch-Bages wine showcases the classic elegance that gives great Pauillac wines their allure. This vintage reveals its power and elegance in a perfectly balanced signature expression, a wine that combines the generosity of a velvety tannic structure with a fine and aromatic complexity.

202 Château Pichon Longueville, Comtesse de Lalande, Pauillac 2nd Growth 2009 €450

Château Pichon-Longueville Lalande is one of the most important **Super Seconds** Grow Pauillac. Estate has made tremendous strides in the last 20 years A beautiful effort, the 2009 Pichon Comtesse, possesses copious mocha, lead pencil, unsmoked, high-class tobacco, black currant, forest floor and herbaceous characteristics. It is a deep purple-hued, charming, surprisingly open-knit Pauillac with wonderful freshness, a plump, fleshy mouthfeel.

204 Château Poujeau St Genes, Bordeaux Superieur 2018 €49

Aromas of liquorice, dark berries and blueberries. Medium bodied with velvety fruits and extremely well integrated tannins and oak that are polished and beautiful.

205 Château Larose Perganson, Haut-Médoc 2014 €77

A deep ruby red in the glass with alluring aromas of bramble fruit, black cherry and hints of sweet spice. The palate is full-bodied with silky, ripe tannins. Concentrated flavours of cassis and blackberry linger on the finish.

206 Château Potensac, Médoc 2013 €90

Correct, old fashioned and like an unadorned beautifully varnished mahogany table, a picture of stark elegance. For the price this is terrific.

207 Château Milles- Roses, Haut-Médoc 2013 (Bio) €72

Black cherries and cassis are mixed with spices, herbs, tobacco and cedar box notes which jump from the glass. The gorgeous soft, plush texture leads the way into the long finish.

208 Château La Mission, Lalande de Pomerol 2017 €65

Rich and rounded raspberry and plum fruits, the softness of the Merlot balanced by the power and structure of the addition of the Cabernet Franc. Full bodied with a long, silky finish.

209 Château Cantenac, Selection Madame, St. Emillion Grand Cru 2019 €70

Seductive nose with aromas of red ripe fruits, balanced by a fine oakiness and delicate spices. Generous mouthfeel, well balanced, blended with fine and fruity tannins. Nice willowy finish, lots of expression.

- 210 1978 Chambertin Joseph Drauhin, Grand Cru, Cote de Nuits €700**
Chambertin is a wine that gives unique sensations, a kaleidoscope of flavours and aromas. The hue is deep with an intense ruby colour. Flavours are opulent and earthy. They evoke black cherry, bitter chocolate then liquorice, black truffle and underbrush. With its massive backbone of velvety tannins in near perfect balance, it has great potential for ageing
- 211 2012 Pommard Les Vacumuriens Jean-Claude Boisset, Côte D'Or €110**
Medium ruby red colour. Scents of red berries, spices and oak on the nose. Dry, developing
With good acidity and medium tannins. Notes of herbs, red fruits, spices and oak.
- 212 Santenay 1er Cru Clos Rousseau, Côte D'Or €72**
Quite a pale ruby. Lots of red fruit on the nose, plum, raspberry, cherry with gentle rose
Perfume. Acidity medium plus. Soft tannins.
- 213 2013 Savigny-Les -Beaune 1er Cru Les Narbantons, Mongeard, Côte D'Or €120**
Aroma of Strawberry and cherry with hints of forest floor. Notes of leather and violets are
Present. Medium acidity with elegant tannin
- 214 2013 Nuits St. George Les Hauts Pruliers, Côte D'Or €155**
Deep ruby in colour. Perfumed nose with lots of red fruits and herbs. Dry, vibrant and fresh
On the palate. Moderate acidity with soft tannins
- 215 2008 Gevrey Chambertin Vieilles Vignes, Domaine Fourrier, Cote de Nuits €110**
Medium cherry colour with pale meniscus; focused, tart red fruit, sous bois, roses, charcoal nose; tasty,
poised, tart red fruit, tart cherry, mineral palate with medium acidity.
- 216 2011 Gevrey Chambertin Vieilles Vignes, Domaine Fourrier, Cote de Nuits €135**
Green leaves on the nose. Sour cherries with spices sitting behind. Develops into ash/smoke.
- 217 2012 Gevrey Chambertin Vieilles Vignes, Domaine Fourrier, Cote de Nuits €120**
Light, earthy, and tangy with excellent black cherry fruit, an emerging top note of citrus peel, and some
botanical herbs for complexity.
- 219 Beaujolais-Villages Lupé-Cholet €40**
Nice light Gamay. Hint of cherries and Blackberries. Elegant easy going for summer time.
- 220 Fleurie Lupé-Cholet €48**
Light, silky and supple with characteristic floral and berry aromas.

221 Morgon Chateau de Pizzay €47

It is said to have the fruitiness of a Beaujolais and the charm of a Burgundy. Wealth of aromas of black fruits mixed with spices: Blackcurrant and white pepper, currants and wild thyme, cherries and chocolate as candies,

Rhône Red Selection

225 2020 Côte-Rotie La Madinieres, Domaine Cuilleron €95

Intense and deep colour with purple highlights. Expressive notes of red and black fruits, Smokey and some wood spices. Balanced, velvety texture of the tannins, roundness of the fruit, Length on freshness.

226 2020 Châteauneuf Du Pape, Closerie de Vaudieu €68

Bright ruby colour, cherries, black currant on the nose with bit of spicy. Fresh medium duration, Touch of acidity and soft tannins.

227 Côtes-du-Rhône-Villages Le Roure Saint-Jean, 'Plan de Dieu' €45

It has a very appealing nose, filled with blueberry and spicy red plum fruit, forward and elegantly sprinkled with white pepper. In the mouth there's a really juicy, lip-smacking fruit quality, chunky tannins and nicely-pitched acidity adding deep support.

228 1962 Cote-Rotie Les Jumelles, Paul Jaboulet €320

The wine is matured for 12 months in oak barrel, with 20%new barrels used. The bouquet is floral, offering notes of red berries or even violet. On the palate, the finish is long, beautiful and harmonious.

229 1978 Hermitage, E. Guigal €210

Wine almost seems more about the sandalwood, warm earth, meaty notes than the pretty wild raspberry and quince notes which are seamlessly woven.

230 1982 Hermitage La Chapelle, Paul Jaboulet €340

Dark plums and dark cherries are vibrant. This is not an overpowering fruit bomb but rather a subtle and complex wine that demands careful attention. Nots of forest floor, leather, very subdued tannins and great complexity. Good acidity and fruity notes made it an outstanding wine.

231 1991 Chateauneuf du Pape La Bernadine, Chapoutier SA €75

Complex and subtle, blackcurrant and plum followed by roasted coffee and cinnamon, cherry, morello cherry. Opening into spicy (liquorice) and fruity aroma

Loire Red Selection

236 Cabernet Franc Chinon, Domaine Grosbois 'La Cuisine de ma Mere' €42

It is undeniably Cabernet Franc, with its purplish colour and fragrant nose which harmoniously combines fruity, floral, vegetal and mineral notes. Aromas of strawberry and raspberry, rose, violet, cedar and pencil lead which intermingle on the nose. The palate is bright, fresh, with crunchy fruitiness.

237 Pinot Noir Sancerre Rouge, Daniel Chotard €50

Sancerre may be best known for its white wines from Sauvignon Blanc, but red wines from Pinot Noir have long been made, too. This is perfumed and sweetly fruited, with summer berry compote filling the mouth. The tannins are juicy and sweet, with a velvety texture.

South West France Red Selection

239 Clos Triguedina Malbec, Cahors €62

Intense flavour of black and red fruits on the nose, reinforced by peppermint and liquorice notes. Supple texture; the bouquet has a good structure and length with concentrated ripe tannins. Fully balanced and rich wine, expressing the traditional Cahors.

Languedoc Red Selection

242 La Clape Château D'Angles €68

Shiraz, Grenache and Mourvèdre blend. Lots of rich dry sweet fruits and figs on the nose. Medium Body, explosive and dark sweet fruit. Spicy, minty and breezy. Round, smooth and pleasant.

243 Carignan De Chansac €39

Deep coloured with rich brambly fruit, the palate is generous, spicy and soft, with flavours of black cherry and raspberry.

Alsace Red Selection

245 Pinot Noir Boeckel Oberpfoeller, Mittelberg Heim, Alsace. (O) €55

There's an initial burst of summer berries on the nose, loganberry, cherry and damson, with trademark Pinot hints of leather, game and dusty forest floor. Bright, tangy red fruits open on the palate, a clean acidic line softening with silky tannins and a layer of savoury, autumnal characters, dried meats with hints of truffle, liquorice and dried herbs.

Italian Red Selection

247 Barolo 'Rocche dell'Annunziata', Piedmont 2015 €93

This is a graceful and elegant Barolo yet with generosity and richness. A pronounced floral personality of violets and roses, followed by strawberry and raspberry fruit and a fanfare on the finish of spice, balsamic hints and wood-smoke. A terrific vintage too.

248 Brunello Di Montalcino, Pian Dell' Orino, Montalcino 2015 €120

Very complex nose of spices, vanilla, chocolate, tar and dried flowers. Full body, palate intense on red fruits, great tannins.

249 Amarone della Valpolicella Folonari, Veneto 2017 €62

Rich and complex Amarone characterised by dried fruit and spice. The colour is deep ruby red with a garnet rim, and a generous, complex nose. There are aromas of jam, raisin and violet, with hints of autumnal spice and balsam.

250 Chianti Classico Fontodi, Greve (O) 2020 €55

A dash of vanilla in a blend of organic Sangiovese makes a wonderful classic chianti. Dry, medium Acidity, medium body wine. Intensity of oak, chocolate, smoke and black cherry are dominant.

251 Barbera D'Alba G.D. Vajra, Piemonte (O) 2022 €50

Ripe strawberry, maraschino cherry, plum. Less acidity than typical Barbera. A mix of velvety and chalky tannins. Hints of leather and tobacco leaves

252 Tenuta delle Terre Nere, Etna Rosso DOC 2006 €115

Pretty, floral and sweet aromas of blue flower and forest floor are doled out in a very controlled and feminine manner. The wine is elegant and refined and shares many of the same characteristics that you would find in a top-rated Pinot Noir.

Georgian Red Selection

256 Saperavi Bedoba, Kakheti Georgia €45
This is a rich and full-bodied red bursting with dark fruits, herbs, mocha, caramel and chocolatey tones. Made from indigenous Georgian grape 'Saperavi' in Georgia's most renowned wine region Kakheti, this wine is definitely for the curious wine drinker.

Spanish Red Selection

259 Toro, Munia "Character", €40
Rich and powerful wine, intense dark fruit notes combining with beeswax, pencil shavings, garrigue, oriental spices and balsamic on the nose. Dried dates, coffee and chocolate on the silky, savoury mid-palate, and ripe cherries and vanilla notes on a long, clean finish.

260 2017 Ribera Del Duero Finca Villacreces €68
Bold, full-bodied. Dense and tannic. Complex mix of fruits and notes of chocolate and oak. Finish is medium long with some spicy notes. Great value.

261 Ameren Selección de Viñedos Rioja Alavesa €42
Dark in colour with slight hues of purple. Full-bodied meaty wine with strawberry jam and Vanilla flavours. This is powerful smooth with silky texture.

262 2018 Baron de Ley "Reserva", Rioja Oriental €46
Some classic Rioja with cherries and hints of smoke on the nose. Easy, fresh and joyful wine

263 2016 Baron de Ley "Grand Reserva" Rioja Alta €59
A round and balanced palate, displaying silky tannins while still remaining fresh and lively. The aftertaste is long and lingering, it offers hints of toasted wood and dried fruits.

Portugal Red Selection

266 Roquette e Cazes, Duoro €58
This classic Duoro red blend is bursting with aromas of ripe bramble fruit, violet and sweet spice. Beautifully structured, with powerful, yet smooth tannins, mouth-watering acidity and a long silky finish.

267 Altano Symington, Duoro (O) €42
Beautifully balanced, very pure, organic red from the Douro valley. The Symington's are the top producers in the area, making some of the greatest ports on the planet, so they know how to handle the famous grapes of the region. Such expertise gorgeous little organic red.

Lebanon Red Selection

- 270** **Chateau Musar Gaston Hocher, Bekaa Valley 2017** **€75**
Garnet with nose of blackcurrant, prune, raspberry, rose and cardamom. Smooth, medium Full body wine. Tannins and acidity are in balance. Delicious!

United States Red Selection

- 272** **Pinot Noir Sokol Blosser, Dundee Hills, Oregon (O)** **€77**
Brick red in colour. Slightly dry, earthy nose. Light with hint of currant, dark cherries and oak. Nice friendly pinot.
- 273** **Zinfandel Seghesio, Sonoma County 2020** **€65**
With a bouquet of cedar, spice, and sun-ripened blackberries, our Sonoma Zinfandel makes a strong first impression. Bold and richly textured on the palate with an intensity and purity of fruit reflected in notes of wild blueberries, plum, and black currants.
- 274** **Cabernet Sauvignon Pine Ridge, Napa Valley 2018** **€95**
Wine leads with pencil shavings and cola aromas. On the palate, cherry, sweet vanilla cream and strawberry share the bill, alongside dusty tannins and a lasting finish that reminds of toasted nuts.
- 275** **Cabernet Sauvignon Chateau Montelena, Napa Valley 2018** **€140**
Floral, elegant, soft with some polish and finesse to the tannins. The fruit is ripe, sweet fresh and juicy, which is perfectly offset by touches of vanilla, espresso, forest floor and spice.

Blueberries, anise, smoked-meats, Asian spice, really lovely aromatics and evocative things happening in the glass. Deliciously fleshy blue fruits, dark cherry, spice and liquorice. Medium bodied cool-climate Shiraz. Brilliant balance and structure with grippy tannins. Aromas of red fruit are complimented by a palate of bright cherry, raspberry and mulberry, with hints of dark chocolate

New Zealand Red Selection

286 Pinot Noir Old Coach Road, Nelson €47

Pale garnet with delicate flavours of ripe black cherries, cranberry, leather, clove and hint of Charred wood. Palate is soft on entry with fine tannins and fresh acidity. Long and fine with Gentle structure.

287 Syrah Trinity Hill, Hawke's Bay €52

Dark berries, liquorice and spice dominant. Well balanced oak with tight tannins. Smooth Texture and fruity aftertaste.

South Africa Red Selection

290 Cabernet Sauvignon Whole Berry Springfield Estate, Robertson €54
Dark purple red with bright edge. Blackberry, cedar, tobacco on the nose. Medium to full Body with good fruit and balance. Graphite character, elegant classic cabernet.

Dark and fruity with leather and musk. Intense full body wine. Smooth, easy to drink. A very well-made Pinotage.

Uruguay Red Selection

293 PRELUDIO Barrel Select Familia Deicas, Canelones €84
Brilliant and complex wine. Wonderfully concentrated and intense with a deep dark fruit profile of dried figs, ripe fruits of the forest and sweet spice. The finish is long and evolving with savoury and herbal complexity framed by ripe, round tannins. A truly world class wine.

Chile Red Selection

294 COYAM Emiliana, Colchagua Valley (O,V) €72
Coyam is Emiliana's iconic blend. This is an elegant and complex wine with lifted notes of cherries, plums, blueberries, and blackberries, along with refreshing hints of black pepper, leather, and pencil lead. The palate is rich and packed with complex fruit character with fresh acidity.

295 Carmènère Antawara Gran Reserva 2018 €46
Dark carmine in colour, this Gran Reserve Carmènère reveals intense aromas of hedgerow fruit, black pepper and prune marmalade. The palate is full and rich, concentrated dark fruits together with toasted oak, smoke and vanilla, with a touch of minerality framed by chocolate powder tannins and well-balanced acidity, and a long, complex finish.
